INFORMATION RELATING TO NOMINATIONS

Eligibility

- You cannot stand for election for the Swinburne Student Council and the Board of Directors at the same time.
- In the case of the Women's Representative, any student who identifies as a woman is eligible to nominate for this role.
- In the case of the Queer Representative, any student who identifies as part of the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, intersex, asexual (LGBTQIA+) community, is questioning, or identifies with any other sexuality or gender identity outside of heterosexual or cisgender norms, is eligible to nominate for this role
- In the case of the International Representative, any student currently enrolled at Swinburne as an international student residing in Australia is eligible to nominate for this role.
- In the case of the Clubs and Sports Representative, any current Swinburne student who is a member of an SSA-affiliated club, society or sporting club is eligible to nominate for this role.
- In the case of the Residential Communities Representative, the nominee must have lived experience (by residing in the Swinburne Student Residences) within six months of their nomination.

Timeline

- Nominations will open at 9:00am (AEST) on Friday 7 August 2026 and close at 12:00pm (midday) sharp on Friday 14 August 2026.
- Completed nomination forms must be received by the Returning Officer, via email, at elections@ssa.edu.au
Please note: your nomination will be rejected if it is not submitted from your Swinburne student email address.
- You are welcome to lodge a photograph, how-to-vote (one single A4 PDF file) and a 200 word candidate policy statement. This must be received by the Returning Officer, via email, by no later than 12:00pm (AEST) Friday 14 August 2026 (the same deadline as close of nominations) at elections@ssa.edu.au
